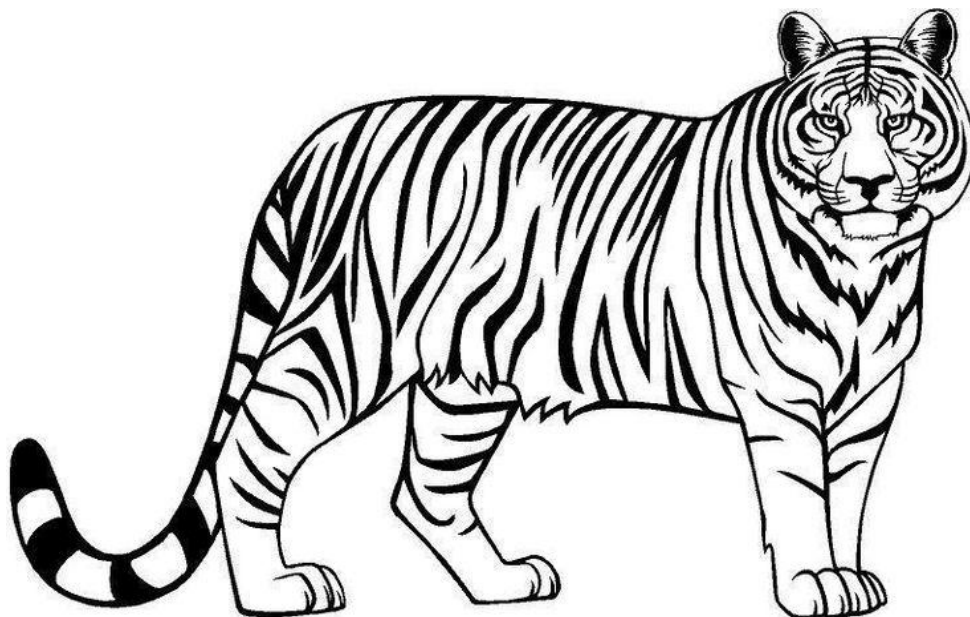

BOYS & GIRLS POLO & DRESS SHIRTS:

Polo Shirts: Interlock, classic mesh or dry /moisture wicking fabric, short or long banded sleeves

Polo Colors: Light Pink, Navy Blue, Red, White, Hunter Green, Cobalt (Royal) Blue, Light Blue, Gray, Black

Dress Shirt: Cotton - white or light blue, long or short sleeve, button-up collar



Note: Long sleeve polos in featured styles & colors may also be worn

BOYS & GIRLS UNIFORM PANTS/SHORTS:

Pants/Short Styles: Solid Poly-Blend Material, side & back slash pockets, boot or slim-leg cut standard or elastic waist Shorts hem to rest at top of knee

Pants/Shorts Colors: Navy Blue, Khaki, Black

Not Allowed: Stretchy, tight-fitting pants, cargo pants/shorts, draw string waist



BOYS & GIRLS FOOTWEAR:

Shoe Style: Athletic sneakers or Mary Janes with supportive arches, bottom tread designed for play/sports

Not Allowed: Light-up shoes, sandals, crocs, boots (all types), non-athletic "Fashion" shoes

Sock Style: Solid color ankle /calf length athletic socks. Girls may wear solid color navy or white knee-highs/tights



BOYS & GIRLS OUTERWEAR:

Outerwear Style: Coats, sweatshirts/sweaters, windbreakers, fleece jackets, vests, scarves, hats, head bands

Outerwear Color: All Outerwear may be one solid color or have a pattern or color-block.
All Tabernacle Tiger Wear is approved

Not Allowed: Logos



BOYS & GIRLS CHAPEL - AWARDS & ASSEMBLY DRESS:

Style: **Khaki** pants, khaki shorts

Or for girls, **Khaki** dresses and skirts

Polo Color: **Navy Blue** polo

GIRLS KNIT POLO DRESSES – JUMPERS – SKIRTS:

Knit Polo Dresses: Light Pink, Navy Blue, Red, White, Hunter Green, Cobalt (Royal) Blue, Light Blue, Gray, Black



Jumpers: Clear Blue Plaid - (Official School Plaid - only plaid allowed) Navy, Khaki, or Black fully pleated or box pleats

Skirts: Clear Blue Plaid full pleat & kick pleat (Official School Plaid - only plaid allowed), Navy, Khaki, or Black full pleat, full skirt, or skorts



Note: Hems on all dresses & skirts are to rest at the top of the knee around the entire skirt.

Note: Full-length solid colored leggings (socks are to cover ankle of leggings), knit tights or bike shorts are to be worn under skirts, dresses & jumpers

PERSONAL GROOMING:

Not Allowed: Unnatural dyes or extreme hairstyles. Heavy face or eye make-up

Girls: Hair is to be clean, brushed & neat

Boys: Hair is to be clean, brushed & neat.

BODY PIERCINGS & TATTOOS:

Not Allowed: Real or temporary tattoos or writing or drawing on body

Piercings: Only ear piercings are permitted. Boys may wear small, single stud style earrings

ACCESSORIES:

Girls: Head bands, bows, clips and beads are allowed

Boys: Hats are allowed - must be removed when indoors

Not Allowed: Headbands with animal ears or distracting accessories. Heavy or long necklaces,
Logos

TECH DEVICES:

Not Allowed: Smart Watches, Fit Bits, Apple Watches, etc.

Cell Phones: allowed - must remain off and stored in student's backpack or locker during school hours. In the event of an emergency, students must receive permission to use their cell phone from a staff member.

FREE DRESS AND THEME DAY DRESS STANDARDS TK – 8th GRADE

BOYS & GIRLS PANTS & SHORTS:

Not Allowed: Overly tight, or ripped jeans, sweatpants, pajama pants, short shorts

Style: Jeans, cargo pants, shorts (hems resting at top of knee) and leggings

Note: leggings must be accompanied by a top that is long enough to rest at mid-thigh)

Tops: Covered shoulders/back – to rest at mid-thigh if wearing leggings

Not Allowed: Low-cut front or back tops, crop tops, violent, controversial, negative images or messages shirts must rest at mid-thigh if wearing leggings

Footwear: Athletic sneakers designed for busy play and sports activities

GIRLS SKIRTS & DRESSES:

Style: Hem must rest at top of knees/front and back, bike shorts or leggings to be worn underneath skirts and dresses

THURSDAYS:

Official Tabernacle T-shirt: Tabernacle T-shirts include those purchased from the school or given for Reading Train, Summer Daycare, or other school events. Must still wear uniform pants, shorts, or skirt.

Earned Free Dress Passes: Must be purchased for three (3) Tiger Coins from the school or awarded from a staff member. Pass must be given to your homeroom teacher at the start of the day.

SPECIAL THEME OR SPIRIT DAYS:

Students may come to school dressed in the designated theme of this day. Themes will be announced in classes and communicated home.

Note: These are not “free dress” days for those not participating within the guidelines of the day’s theme.
